Who:

- Any adult leaders responsible for the Boy Scout outdoor program
- Webelos leaders responsible for Webelos Den outdoor program

Goals: When you finish the course:

- Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, and other Troop Adult Leadership should:
 - Have had hands on knowledge of setting up a campsite, pitching a tent, hiking, outdoor cooking.
 - Be proficient in the basic outdoor skills through First Class rank
 - Have ability to show their scouts how to accomplish outdoor skills while fulfilling rank requirements
 - Have the confidence necessary to see the Boy Scout outdoor program to come to life
- Webelos Leaders should:
 - Be able to explain how the outdoor program runs progressively through Scouting's age levels
 - List the Webelos Scout advancement requirements related to the outdoor program
 - Understand the values of the outdoor program
 - Have the confidence to provide a memorable camping experience for their Webelos Scouts and parents or guardians
