RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**GROUPS PRIOR TO SETTING UP CAMP  
MUST CHECK IN AT THE REGISTRATION TABLE**

All event participants are reminded that the Camporee/Weboree is being held in Private Religious camp property and as such, all of us are personal guests of Camp Milldale. All participants must conform to the requirements as specified by the site owner. Everyone's cooperation is expected and appreciated.

***TRASH FACILITIES WILL BE AVAILABLE AT CAMP MILLDALE  
\* NO TRASH OR GARBAGE IS TO BE BURNED OR BURIED AT CAMPSITE \****

**Alcoholic Beverages and Drugs - Possession and /or use of alcoholic beverages or drugs are prohibited. You will be evicted from the Camporee/Weboree if found with either.**

**Smoking - National Policy states that smoking is not only a safety hazard, but also objectionable in the presence of youth. Therefore, smoking will not be permitted in Camp**

**Electronic Devices - Radios, video games, tape decks, etc. are not permitted at Camp Milldale.**

**Responsibility - There must be at least two (2) adult leaders in camp responsible for their units at all times. A minimum of one adult leaders, and SPL from each unit are expected to attend Friday and Saturday Night Leaders Meetings.**

**OFF LIMIT Areas - All Youth participants will confine themselves to the campsite area. Known off limit areas will be discussed at Friday nights Leaders meeting.**

**Camp Milldale permanent restroom facilities are for adult use only! The Spot-A-Pots are for youth use.**

**Fire Pits and Rain Trenches - Do not dig holes or trenches. Above ground fires only NO EXCEPTIONS only "*above the ground fires*" in a drums or barrels will be allowed.**

**Vehicles - Only emergency vehicles (designated by the Staff) will be allowed in Camp. All other vehicles must be parked in the designated parking areas.**

**Uniforms - Class 'A' uniforms are required for assemblies, meetings, religious services. All other activities are subject to weather.**

**Early Departures - In the event that any registered Adult leader or Youth must leave the Camporee site for any reason, please notify one of the Staff or the units designated Area Directors.**

**Sheath Knives serve no useful purpose at the camporee and therefore, not permitted. They will be confiscated by Staff or Area Director if found.**

**Complaints - Constructive suggestions for improvements of Future Camps are welcome at the Saturday Night Leaders Meeting.**

  - a. 1<sup>st</sup> place
  - b. 2<sup>nd</sup> place
  - c. 3<sup>rd</sup> place
6. There will be sign-ups for judging time slots to be posted Friday evening- please include name of dish, contact person and unit number.
7. \*\*Main Dish judging will begin 5:00 pm and proceed at 10 minute intervals.  
\*\*Dessert judging to begin at 6 pm and proceed at 10 minute intervals.

8. Please prepare qty. 4 - 4 oz. servings and have accompanying utensils as necessary.
