Dear Eagle Scout:

Sounds good doesn't it! Congratulations on attaining the rank of Eagle! You now have joined the select group of your fellow Scouts by successfully completing the requirements of the highest rank available to Boy Scouts, the rank of Eagle.

Now the next step – Your Eagle Court of Honor. This is where, we will publicly recognize your advancement to Eagle, and then charge you with the challenge to live your life as an Eagle Scout.

This is **YOUR** Eagle Court of Honor. The very first step you must take is deciding upon and securing a date and location. Allow yourself at least 3 months to plan and prepare this important event. As soon as you know the date and location, let you troop know. Your troop will want to include this date in their calendar. As an Eagle Scout you will be challenged to start giving back to the scouting program some of what you received. The first thing you need to do is to encourage those boys younger than you to advance. It is important to the continued growth of your unit and the development of the scouting program to invite not only the entire troop, but equally important the Cub Scout Pack that normally feeds your unit. You want to remind the parents and their boys that they too can become an Eagle Scout.

Your troop will provide you with a certain amount of support for your Eagle Court of Honor. Your committee chair should be giving you a letter detailing what the troop will do and what your responsibilities are. If they have not, **ASK THEM BEFORE YOU LEAVE TO GO HOME TODAY!** Be humbly proud of your accomplishments', remembering that you did not achieve this rank by yourself – as you were encouraged down the trail to Eagle, you now need to start encouraging all those scouts from the youngest Tiger Cub to the oldest Life scout, that they too are expected to one day stand in front of a group, gathered to recognize their accomplishments' in earning the rank of Eagle.

Congratulations again, best wishes to you and your family. We look forward to your Eagle Court of Honor!
