

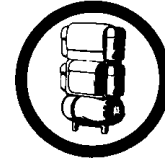

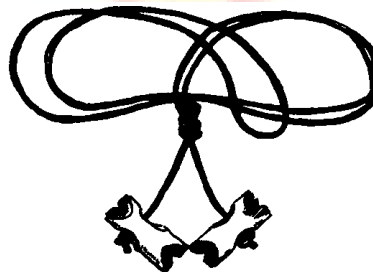

Everything to be Prepared*



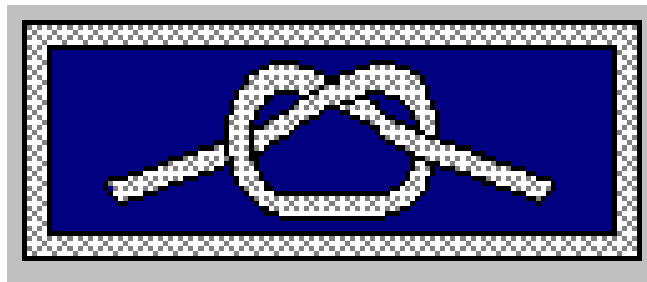

He has earned the Cubmaster Award, Cub Scouter Award, Webelos Den Leader Award, Den Leader Training Award, and is a James E. West fellow.

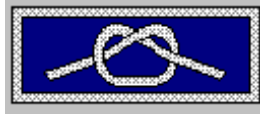
