**Constellation of the Month: Lepus**, the Hare. Situated at the feet of Orion and just in front of Canis Major, the Hare appears to be in imminent danger. In a Germanic myth, the Hare was once a bird, transformed by Ostara, the Goddess of Spring. She let the Hare retain in avian speed, however, and each spring it was allowed to lay eggs. This myth may be the seed that gave us the tradition of the Easter Bunny eggs.

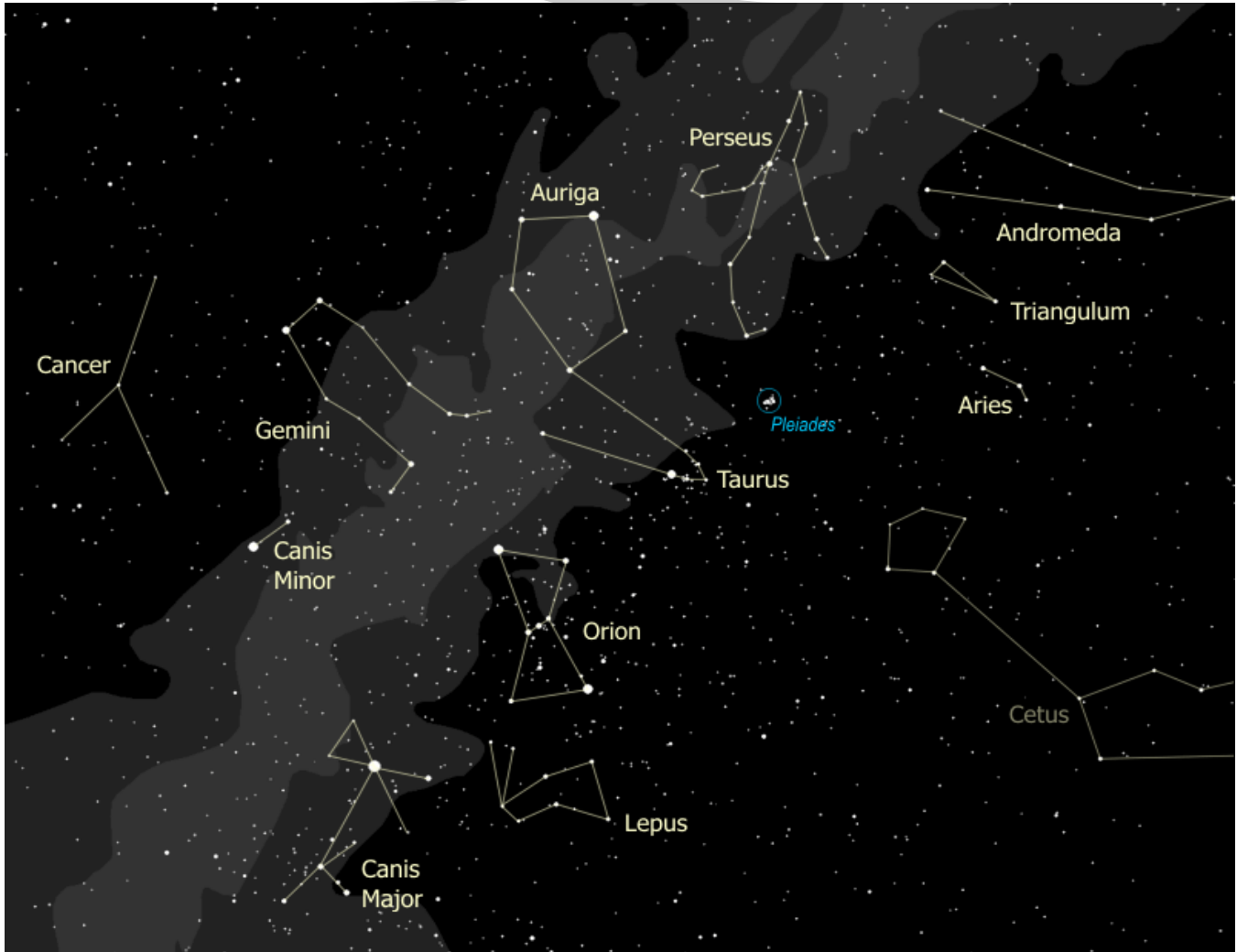
