## Constellation of the Month: Libra

Libra was the last sign added to the Zodiac. The two brightest stars were once part of the constellation Scorpius. In ancient times, the autumnal equinox occurred when the Sun crossed the celestial equator in Libra; therefore the scale represented the equalizing of day and night. Libra is also associated with justice.

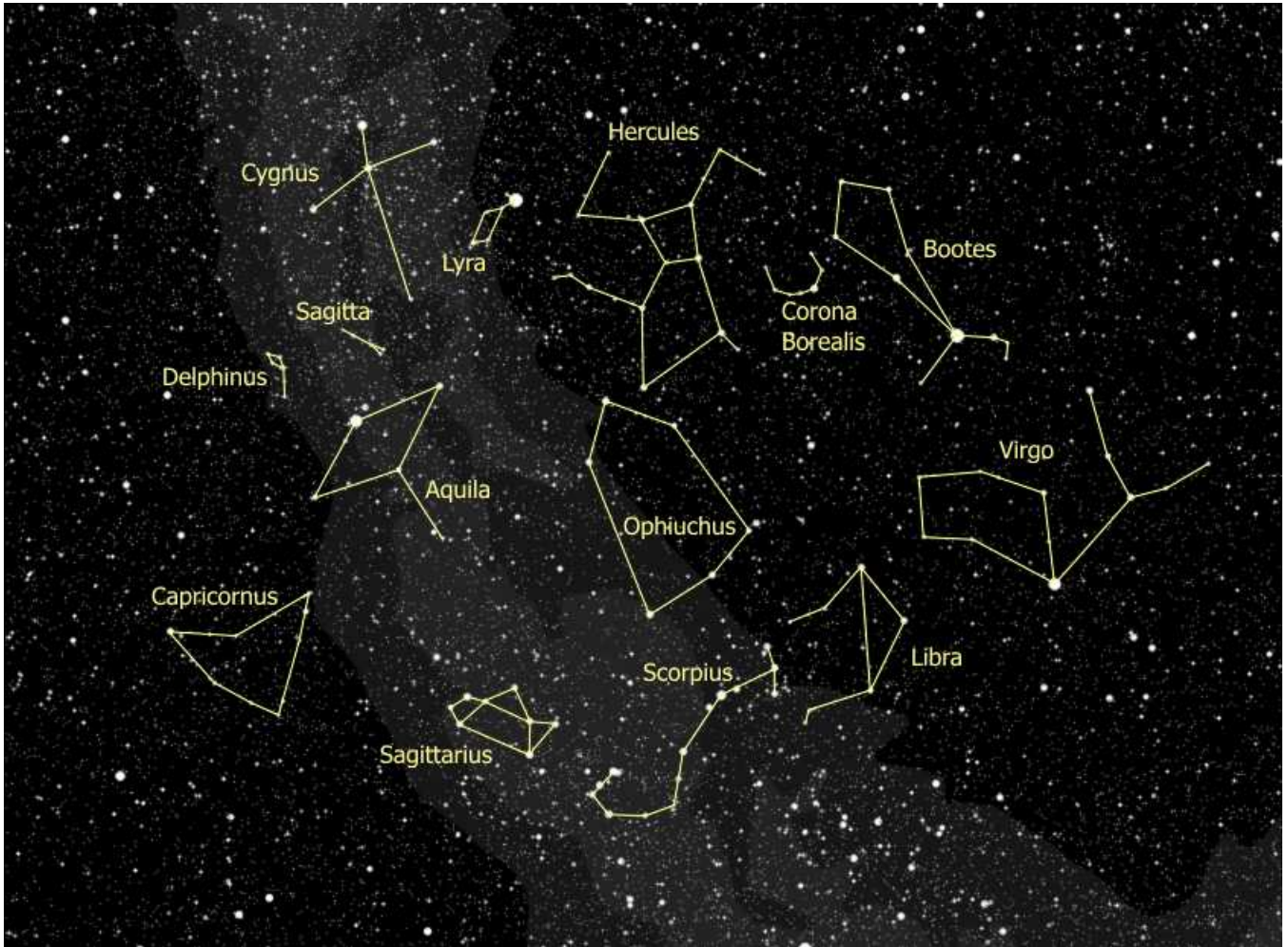
