Constellation of the Month: Corona Borealis, the Northern Crown. There are lots of stories about ancient Greek constellation, but all agree that it represents the crown that Princess Ariadne of Crete wore. The constellation contains Tau Coronae Beorealis, the Blaze Star a recurrent nova. It is made of a companion white dwarf and red giant stars. The red giant transfers gas to the white dwarf causing periodic explosions.

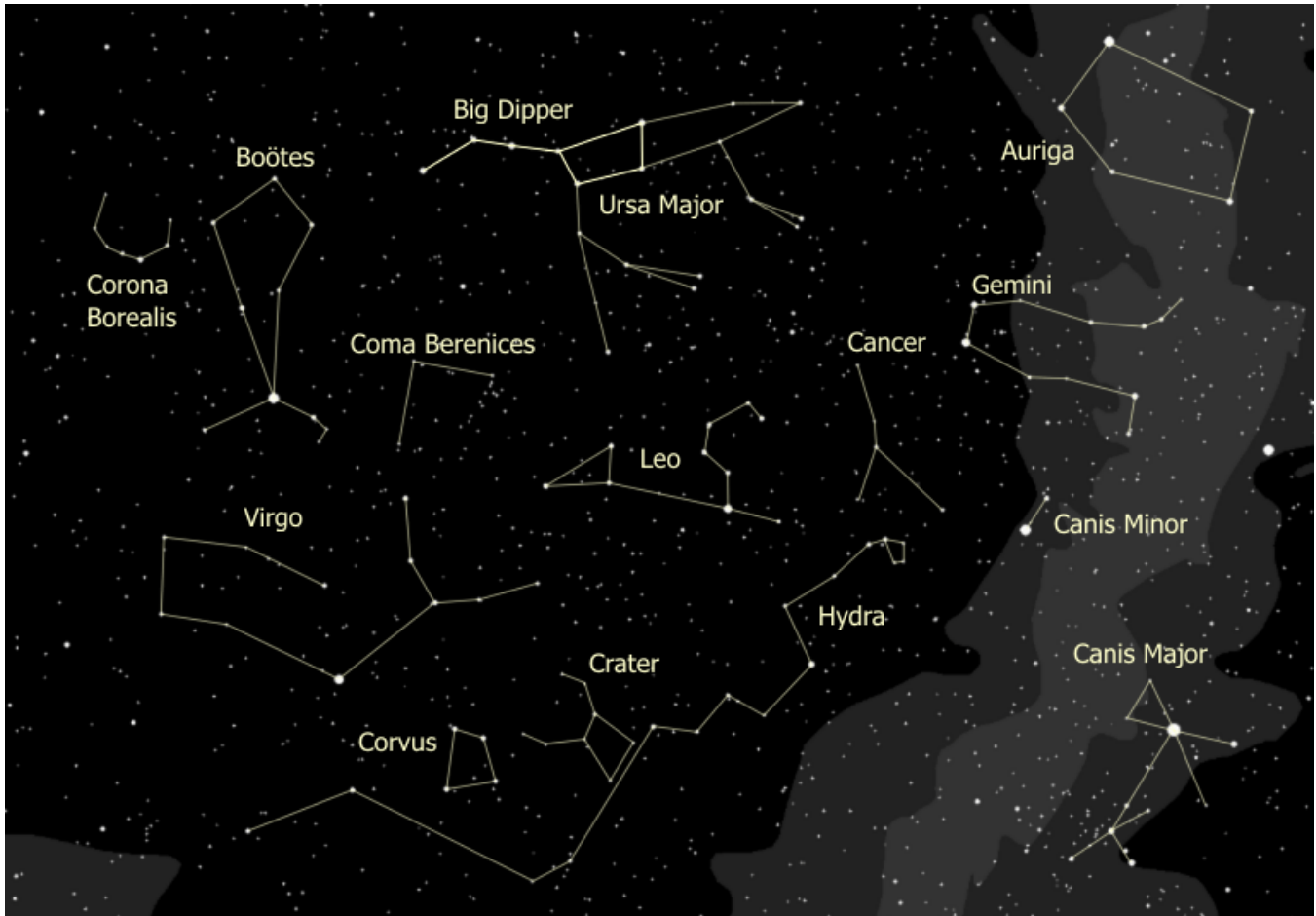
